## e-Services: It's Easy To Be Green

When you sign up for e-Services, it's not only easy to help the environment, but you will also be helping yourself and the credit union. Here's how: When you go online to make a loan payment or transfer funds, you save a trip to the credit union and the emissions that go along with it. Online services are available anytime, day or night, too, putting the credit union at your fingertips on your schedule, not ours.

With e-Statements, you will receive an email alerting you that your statement is ready. Although you can print it out, there's no need to. You can view it online and then save it to your desktop or a storage device, like a thumb drive. That saves paper and postage. And because your credit union is a non-profit financial cooperative, any savings are returned to you in the form of lower rates on loans, higher rates on savings, or better services. Plus, less paper means less clutter.

THE 2012 GEORGIA POWER NORTHWEST FEDERAL CREDIT UNION ANNUAL MEETING WILL BE HELD FRIDAY, JANUARY 27, 2012. THE MEETING WILL BE HELD AT THE ROME CITY AUDITORIUM AND WILL BEGIN AT 7:00 P.M. DOOR PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED AT THE CONCLUSION OF REGULAR BUSINESS.

THE PRIMARY PURPOSES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING IS TO GIVE THE MEMBERSHIP THE OPPORTUNITY TO SELECT WHICH MEMBERS WILL REPRESENT THEM ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. THE BOARD MEMBERS VOLUNTEER TIME AND EFFORT ENSURING THAT OUR CREDIT UNION REMAINS FINANCIALLY STRONG AND CONTINUES TO MEET THE NEEDS OF OUR MEMBERS. DIRECTORS SERVE 3 YEAR TERMS.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE TO SELECT QUALIFIED MEMBERS TO APPEAR ON THE BALLOT FOR SEATS ON THE BOARD. THIS YEAR THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF MARTHA ROGERS, SHERRI HOOPER, AND STEVE EDGE. THEIR NOMINATIONS FOR THE THREE EXPIRING TERMS ARE:

IN 1988, AN AMENDMENT WAS ADOPTED THAT ALLOWS A QUALIFIED MEMBER TO BE INCLUDED ON THE BALLOT THROUGH A PETITION PROCESS. IF YOU WANT TO PETITION TO APPEAR ON THE BALLOT, PLEASE PROVIDE A MEMBER OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE WITH THE FOLLOWING:

1. A PETITION BY AT LEAST 250 MEMBERS, EACH OF WHOM IS AT LEAST SIXTEEN (16) YEARS OF AGE AND HAS A MINIMUM OF FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) IN SHARES.
2. A BRIEF SUMMARY OF QUALIFICATIONS AND BIOGRAPHICAL OUTLINE.
3. A SIGNED STATEMENT CONFIRMING THAT YOU ARE AGREEABLE TO THE NOMINATION AND WILL SERVE IF ELECTED.
4. MUST BE RECEIVED BY NOMINATING COMMITTEE BY SPECIFIED DATE.
5. ALL NOMINEES MUST BE IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE CREDIT UNION.

THIS INFORMATION MUST BE FILED WITH A MEMBER OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE BY DECEMBER 10, 2011. THE FINAL LIST OF NOMINEES WILL BE POSTED IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS BY DECEMBER 17, 2011. THE ELECTION WILL BE HELD BY BALLOT ONLY IF THERE IS MORE THAN ONE NOMINATION FOR ANY VACANCY.
